	All of the above are stored in their original containers, not in dishes or containers used for food and drink.
	Cleaning products are never mixed together. This could make a poisoning gas.
	My family always follows instructions when taking or giving medicine. (Remember: more is not better!)
	My home has carbon monoxide alarms on every level, and batteries are replaced yearly.
	All expired, unwanted, or leftover medicines have been safely discarded. (Visit www.fda.gov for instructions)
