

Blue Ridge Poison Center Home Safety Checklist

- Medicines, cleaning products, pesticides, alcohol, nicotine products, and all household chemicals are kept up high, out of the sight and reach of children.
- All of the above are stored in their original containers, not in dishes or containers used for food and drink.
- Cleaning products are never mixed together. This could make a poisoning gas.
- My family always follows instructions when taking or giving medicine. (Remember: more is not better!)
- My home has carbon monoxide alarms on every level, and batteries are replaced yearly.
- All expired, unwanted, or leftover medicines have been safely discarded. (Visit www.fda.gov for instructions)
