  - o Aerospace Medicine Interest Group
    - Presented by Jay Shah
    - Purpose is to expose medical students to the field of Aerospace Medicine (aka medical treatment of astronauts).
    - Jay has spoken to past co-workers at NASA who would be interested in coming down to speak to the club
      - Recommended club register with CIO which would help pay for travel expenses of speakers for the club
    - Group approved with budget of \$90
- Curriculum Committee Update
  - Clerkships directors
    - Ob/Gyn: Bray → Latimer
    - New surgical clerkship directors
    - All current ACEs approved for next year
    - Talk about making grading system standardized
      - Currently 3rd year grades are based on wards, shelf exams, sometimes OSCEs, however the math is not currently straight forward. Students given a percentage, but some clerkships curve differently and define different cutoffs for As and Bs
      - Within the next year, the hope is to make grades more standardized in order to make grading more transparent.

    - Last year Newcomb plaza was reserved for the 5k which was free. However, technically that's not allowed and so we were unable to reserve it there again.
    - Booked Nameless field for 3/31. Cost will be \$200. However, Nameless filed has a new policy where if you have Non-UVA students/faculty participating in active event, need 1 million

- dollars in general liability insurance. Approximately 1/3 of attendees last year were not students/faculty.
- Need to have insurance coverage by 10 days prior to the event or make it only for UVA students/faculty.
- Hoping there was some way to fulfill this requirement from either
  - School of Medicine → Liz and Brie directed Cat and Maggie to Dean Densmore and Jill Clarke in hopes to find insurance coverage for the event
  - Camp Holiday → Can also reach out to Camp Holiday and see if they have insurance that could cover the event
- Could change the location to a local park such as Washington State Park, but that would require Charlottesville City approval. Not ideal.
- Question of whether or not to publicize the event since there are still details up in the air
  - Will let students know of event
  - Waiting to advertise to the public until after we get confirmation about insurance
