- Creation of new position - Pre-medical Mentoring chair (Corey Benjamin, SMD20)
 - Special election for SMD21 chair
 - Corey Benjamin wants to create and head this new chair. He wrote responsibilities to put in the constitution for this chair that are listed below.
 - Corey has already been in contact with the undergraduate Pre-Health advising office and multiple pre-med/pre-health undergraduate groups.

- MAA position change
 - Special election for SMD20 representative
 - Would make the MAA position a 3 year term.
 - Consistent people in charge would be preferred.
 - Would allow for one person from each class to be an MAA rep.
 - Modifications to the position are outlined below
 - Motion was approved to modify this position.
- Constitution review & Bylaws creation
 - Separate meeting
 - Separate meeting will review changes that have occurred to the Constitution in the past year and any final edits
 - Goal is to solidify the constitution before we start working on bylaws

The **Pre-Medical Mentoring Chairs** shall

1. Be one incoming 1st year elected in the fall and one 2nd year elected the previous year.
2. Shall serve for two years, from the fall election of 1st year through the fall election 3rd year.
3. Serve as a liaison between the School of Medicine and the undergraduate Pre-Health Advising office for the sharing of information of mutual interest.
4. Serve as a point of contact between the School of Medicine and any undergraduate pre-medical student groups.
5. Organize events in conjunction with the Pre-Health Advising office including, but not limited to, organizing an annual mentoring panel.
6. Match interested medical students with undergraduate mentees.

7. Attend monthly Mulholland meetings.

The **Medical Alumni Association (MAA) Representatives (3)** shall

- A. Be one rising 2nd year student elected in the spring who will serve a three-year term through spring elections of their graduation year. The remaining two representatives shall be one rising 3rd year and one rising 4th year who are serving three-year terms having been elected as rising 2nd years.**
- B. Be dedicated to leading their class through the transition between student and alumni.
- C. Attend all Medical Alumni Association Board of Directors meetings and speak and vote on issues facing the Board of Directors on behalf of the student body.
- D. Assist in organizing events in conjunction with the Medical Alumni Association including, but not limited to, the White Coat Ceremony, MAA Annual Meetings, Match Day, and MedConnect events.
- E. Spearhead and coordinate the committee in charge of implementing the 4th year class giving campaign to the MAA.
- F. Lead the MAA Ambassador Club along with a staff member of the MAA, including communicating tasks to club members, leading a yearly meeting, recruiting new members, and giving input for club projects.
- G. Serve on the Alumni Relations Committee which consists of monthly conference calls.
- H. Update the Society on all issues pertaining to the Medical Alumni Association.**
- I. Introduce the first year class to the Medical Alumni Association during Orientation.**
