 - o Dr. Gusic explained what an EPA (Entrustable Professional Activity) is, as well as the context in which they are applied throughout 4 years of education
 - o Concerns brought up with Dr. Gusic about EPAs
 - Logistics of actually starting/finishing EPAs with attendings, residents, fellows seeming resistant or unwilling; Dr. Gusic responded that this issue will be solved with a culture change that is in progress but will take time
 - Students feel uncomfortable asking for EPAs to be performed, continually apologize; Dr. Gusic responded that this seems to be a problem on the side of the faculty & will again require a culture change
 - Students feel this could negatively impact their grade; Dr. Gusic responds that there are consequences for the faculty to not perform correctly, will work with the chairs of departments - criteria for faculty to be paid/promoted/etc. - students feel this needs to be more obvious
 - Students feel as if they are not getting enough feedback for it to be worth their time; Dr. Gusic responds they are having orientation/teaching opportunities with faculty on feedback
 - Students worry that residents/faculty will be burnt out on number of evaluations; Dr. Gusic responds that the clerkship evaluation has been revamped to remove any duplication from EPA as well as allowing requirements for both to be filled at the same time
 - Students concerned about master assessor availability; Dr. Gusic recruiting more, increased time commitment, decreasing necessity for specific rotations
 - Students have concerns about the interface of the website; Dr. Gusic will research
