- Ophthalmoscope Rental Program
 - o POC: Varun Jain
 - Preliminary Survey Results
 - With Mulholland approval, will reach out to FCM & AIM coordinators to explain our intent and seek their input/approval
 - Proposed program:
 - Obtain donated ophthalmoscopes & rent them out to first year students for FCM
 - Potentially, also to third-year students for AIM course?
 - Students would sign out ophthalmoscopes by FCM day
 - Estimated cost would be approximately \$35-40 per person per year
 - So far 15 people willing to donate their scopes
 - Seeking volunteers to pick up scopes from donors in Charlottesville

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- Creation of SOM Social Media Chair/Director/Czar/Ruler
 - Instagram and Facebook have been heretofore informally managed
 - o Propose creation of formalized, elected position within Mulholland Society
 - o If approved, will draft constitutional amendment and send out prior to June 2020 meeting
 - Proposed position
 - Elected representative(s) would manage all UVASOM social media accounts (Instagram, Facebook)
 - Discussion concluded in agreement that it would be best to have an elected representative from each class to (1) distribute the workload to more people and (2) diversify the content and ensure equal representation of all student endeavors, values, and interests
 - There was a motion to create the position of Social Media Representative for each class (4 total representatives)
 - Motion was carried
- Creation of 4th Year Community Service Chair position and Community Service Committee
 - Debate pros/cons
 - Proposed structure:

 - 4th year chair, 3rd year vice chair, 1-2 reps per class
 - Committee would be free to appoint webmaster, social media guru, POCs for various programs etc (non-elected positions)
 - Thoughts from current/former CSCs
 - COVID Initiative proposal for transitioning to Mulholland Community Service
 - Needs Constitutional amendment (amendment will be drafted and emailed, and then would be voted on at June 2020 meeting)
 - Retain current Community Service Chairs as Committee Reps for their class
 - Expect to vote new officers into positions in Fall 2020 if this amendment is passed
 - Discussion points:
 - Proposed that the Mulholland Society should create 2 new elected positions to lead the Community Service Committee (CSC)
 - Goal of the CSC would be to create a "VMED volunteering network" that could facilitate student participation in a wider array of community service opportunities throughout Charlottesville by listing all opportunities in one central location
 - Increase overall SOM community involvement
 - Facilitate easier access to volunteer opportunities for students
 - Create a platform for student service initiatives
 - May need students to help transition this program over the summer from a Covid-19-centric network to a broader community network
 - SMD23 students? (since clinical rotations restart in June)
 - Discussion is ongoing update for vote forthcoming
