Dear Colleagues:

We have expanded the previously announced availability of COVID-19 testing in the ERC building to better accommodate health system and team member needs. We are temporarily eliminating testing at the Student Activities Building for at least the next few weeks.

Effectively immediately, all COVID-19 testing will be performed in the ERC building M-F. Testing availability is for all team members, both patient facing and non-patient facing.

- The hours are 0700-1700 this week and next week (Monday-Wednesday).
- After Thanksgiving, ERC testing hours will be 0800-1700.
- Again, you must call in advance (243-9534) for an appointment time.
- If there is no answer, please leave a message.
- Calls will be returned within 2 hours, volume permitting.
