- 3D Printing Club funding request follow-up and vote
 - Who would have access to the printer? —> undergrads/BME students?
 - Also got 15-20 interested students, some who have built up 3D printers from the ground up

Q&A

1. Who will have access to the printer? Only medical students, or will students from other programs or undergrads be able to access the 3D printer if working alongside medical students?

Med students and, in the spirit of interdisciplinary collaboration, select graduate and undergraduate students from other programs that work with us and are trained by our team.

2. What is the estimated cost of upkeep (i.e., ink, etc.)? Will funding for ink or repairs be requested as needed via future funding requests?

Filament is priced at 15-20\$/kg. This would certainly need replenishment for projects (although optionally students with ideas could be encouraged to bring their own filament). Maintenance costs are variable and uncommon in new printers but usually are on the scale of 10\$ in parts + labor.

3. Who will do repairs if needed?

Fortunately, we now have multiple members (including at least one M1) with experience building printers from the ground up who very well may be able to perform basic service on the specific model we hope to purchase.

4. Do you anticipate receiving grant money? If so, will that go towards the cost of a new printer? What is the timeline of the grant application process and the estimated likelihood of the 3D printing club receiving this grant?

We are currently working with faculty on a proposal to expand 3d printing facilities available for health system faculty, staff, and students. This would hopefully provide further research publication and grant-writing opportunities (The types of printers in this grant would have specific features-- like full-color printing, high resolution, soluble support capabilities-- that would require more expenses than a consumer grade standalone printer (like the one we are looking to purchase for club use).

5. Does the 3D printing club receive funding from any other sources?

No other funding sources.

6. Can medical students access other 3D printers on campus? What are the specific barriers to accessing these existing printers?

The existing health system library printer is unfortunately in disrepair. With advances in 3d printing technology we have been told that it may be better to get a newer printer (that we would be able to maintain ourselves) vs. repair the old one, which may cost more than a new printer. Some of the reasons the original health system library printer was purchased was to decrease barriers to usage-- specifically having to pay high rates for printer use, commute long distances during business hours, or be trained in multiple steps etc.-- and to encourage the use of more of the library's expertise and resources. For situations where specialized printing features are desired (for example, for printing using metal or resin),

though, we definitely think students' best bets should be to seek those out in respective makerspaces (School of Engineering, School of Architecture).
