● Updates + Debriefs

- Overall Mulholland Society budget is still under review by admin
- 3D Printing Club - funding request for new 3D printer (Jasraj Raghuvanshi)
 - HSL has not had a 3D printer for several years. It is out of the library's budget to repair or replace this printer.
 - 3-D Printer is not available within the SOM. Dr. Trowbridge (faculty leader of UVA Medical Design) no longer works at UVA; he has moved to a new job.
 - 3-D Printing Club leadership team conducted research on the highest quality, cost-effective printer, which they found for \$250. This specific

printer will require minimal maintenance. Cost for 1 kg roll of filament:
\$15

- Goal of the printer: foster education for 3-D printing through tutorials, partnering with Dr. Moyer for anatomical models, assisting student research project and providing an opportunity for students interested in 3-D printing to further their interest/learn more
- Anticipate the cost will come from 2022-2023 Mulholland Budget
- Discussion for this funding request will continue after we receive approval for the new budget

- Student Wellness Reform

 - Reinstating the Wellness Steering Committee (in communication with Drs. Barry and Redick) and starting a student policy proposal
 - Seems that students in the past have proposed the idea of embedded counselors in the SOM/SON, but funding has been an issue - Dean Keeley is involved and this is an ongoing topic of conversation
 - Ideas currently discussed: psychiatrist present on-campus for SOM students exclusively; possible program where CAPS would be required to set up an appointment with each student at the beginning of the year, but students would have the opportunity to opt-out if would like
 - Met with representatives from the SON Compassionate Care Initiative
 - Goal is to propose a multi-pronged approach to administration, compiling research from other schools
 - Preliminary responses on Wellness Reform Survey
 - Protected time off during pre-clerkship, clerkship and 4th for wellness; release of each rotation's schedule earlier on to allow for planning
 - Wellness Lecture: varied thoughts
 - Understanding that wellness looks different for each student and students should be given the time off to

practice wellness in whichever way they prefer rather than being required to watch lectures

- Lectures may be beneficial to sharing tools for wellness strategies
- Hearing primarily from fellow students, residents and attendings about their own experiences if lectures must be continued
- Incorporating interactive activities such as art therapy, healthy eating workshops and therapy dogs for wellness lectures
 - Integration of wellness at curriculum level
 - Overwhelming support for on-staff psychiatrist and psychologist
 - Please reach out to us if you are interested in helping with these efforts.
