### 2024 Trainee Diversity & Inclusion Conference

Dear Medical Students,

We are excited to invite you to HCDI's 6th Annual Trainee Diversity and Inclusion Conference (TDIC), which will be on Saturday, April 13th, from 8am – 3pm! This year, we are eager to center our efforts on a pressing issue – housing insecurity and its impact on health outcomes. We are examining this issue from various perspectives: community, health system, and the political/infrastructural. This conference also aligns with National Fair Housing Month in April. The theme for this year's conference is "Bridging Home & Health: Mobilizing Healthcare in the Fight Against Housing Insecurity," and our keynote speaker is Dr. Calvin Johnson – Deputy Assistant Secretary for Research, Evaluation, and Monitoring at the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) & Commissioner of the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights.

We aim to foster multidisciplinary discussions, engaging community partners, health system intra- and post-hospitalization housing experts, and housing policy experts. By doing so, we seek to understand the current landscape of housing insecurity comprehensively. We also aim to explore how trainees, faculty, and staff can be attuned to these challenges when caring for patients while discussing effective advocacy strategies to ensure optimal care post-hospitalization despite prevalent structural inequalities.

We hope you will be able to join us in person during this year's conference. We are also offering a virtual option as it allows for built-in flexibility with time commitments and opens the discussion to interested individuals across the nation. If you cannot attend in person, please pass on the word to someone else who might! This conference is open to medical students, trainees, faculty, nurses, APPs, and staff from UVA and other institutions. Breakfast, lunch, and most importantly coffee will be provided.
