Since we have had many officer transitions as of late, here's a quick rundown on how to request funding and reimbursement from Mulholland. Please review the procedure as a few minor changes have been made. Also, please bear with us as things get more hectic toward the end of the year!

I. How to request funds

Please submit all funding requests using the online form at least TWO WEEKS in advance of your event. All funding requests must receive approval from the Board which is why at least two weeks' notice is required to give the Board a chance to review the funding request and ask any pertinent questions as they see fit. Then I will send you an email letting you know whether your request was approved or denied. If you are requesting pizza for your event, I will email you AFTER your request is approved so we can gather additional info about your event and submit your order. My email is <u>JUN4WX@virginia.edu</u>, so look out for an email from me. This is a great way to get many pizzas for a low price so I highly suggest you all try it out!

2. How to submit reimbursements

Within 2 weeks of your event concluding, please submit a reimbursement request using the online form. You must upload the ACH form (unless you have already submitted one this past academic year) so our bank can deposit your reimbursement. A copy of the ACH form you need to fill out is on the reimbursement form but it is also linked here. Please make sure you upload a receipt. Reimbursement requests are processed by our accounting department in batches.

Direct Deposits are usually deposited on Friday afternoon.

DEAN KEELEY'S CORNER



Congratulations to SMD24 on an amazing match! As we gear up for the next cycle, I am sharing information about the Medical Student Performance Evaluation, sometimes referred to as the Dean's Letter, which is a templated summary prepared by the medical school for every student entering the residency match. The MSPE is standardized across schools to allow residency directors to easily locate data and facilitate holistic evaluation of applicants.

There are six sections:

- Identifying Information name and school
- <u>Noteworthy Characteristics</u> students write 3 bulleted points-each is 2 sentences and may reference an experience or a hardship, something not found elsewhere in your application or something you may want to emphasize. Your College Dean will assist you with editing as appropriate.
- <u>Academic History</u> -dates of matriculation and graduation, any leaves of absence, combined degrees, required repeat of coursework, any adverse action such as academic probation or suspension
- <u>Academic Progress</u> —narrative comments from all clinical coursework edited by your College Dean to enhance readability but not edited for content. For each clerkship the grading rubric and a histogram of grades for the class is included with an arrow for your grade.
- <u>Summary</u> —although some schools rank students, the UVA MSPE notes that neither grade point average nor class rank is calculated and that this letter serves as a comprehensive assessment of each student.
- <u>Medical School Information</u> —includes summary of our curriculum and requirements including description of the EPA program

The MSPE does not include notation of any exam failures, OSCE or CPX performance or concern

cards all of which are internal assessments that are not shared. The College Deans do not add

any additional information about issues or discussions you may have through the course of medical school. The MSPE is a summary letter of evaluation, not a letter of recommendation. You "write" your MSPE with your clinical performance and your College Dean assembles it. Students have the opportunity to review the letter prior to the national release to residency programs.

Once an MSPE has been released, it cannot be altered but an addendum can be added if entering the match again. The MSPE is also required for fellowship training application and graduates can request the letter from our Student Affairs office.

UVA HEALTH COMMUNITY PROGRAM: SPORTS PHYSICALS FOR VULERNABLE YOUTH

UVA Health and many team members have been offering youth Sports Physicals in the community to vulnerable families with limited access to health care in the past. This year, we have coordinated with different clinical departments (Family Medicine, Pediatrics, Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation and Internal Medicine) to support this community health service in collaboration with the Department of Diversity and Community Engagement. UVA Health teams will offer a number of Sports Physical events in public schools during May and June of this year so that youth can participate in competitive school sports during the following academic year. Teams on site will include, medical/nursing students, house staff, nurses, advance practice provides, faculty and others. We are looking for volunteers with passion to serve the community and support vulnerable and minority youth as sports participation enables these children to develop strong sense of belonging and many other benefits that sports participation brings.

The community based sports physicals sessions will happen at two local High Schools in May and June. We will need 2-4 general volunteers, 4-6 students, 4-8 residents, and 3-4 attendings to help out each shift in the schedule below.

REED PSYCHIATRIC CARE FUND

MESSAGE FROM RAMONA REED, MD '68 WHEN I WAS A MEDICAL STUDENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA FROM 1964-1968, I SUFFERED AN EPISODE OF MAJOR DEPRESSION AND WAS SEXUALLY ABUSED BY A PSYCHOTHERAPIST. I WANTED TO RECEIVE HELP FROM A FACULTY MEMBER BUT COULD NOT AFFORD TO PAY FOR CARE IN THE PHYSICIAN'S PRIVATE PRACTICE. I HAVE WANTED FOR MANY YEARS TO TURN THESE NEGATIVE EXPERIENCES INTO SOMETHING POSITIVE. I HOPE THAT, AS A RESULT OF THE PROGRAM MY HUSBAND AND I HAVE MADE POSSIBLE, NO OTHER MEDICAL STUDENT AT UVA WILL EVER BE IN THE SITUATION I FACED.

I COMPLETED MY RESIDENCY IN PSYCHIATRY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO HEALTH SCIENCES CENTER IN 1972 AND A FELLOWSHIP AT COLORADO STATE HOSPITAL IN 1973. I DEVELOPED A SUCCESSFUL PRIVATE PRACTICE IN ADULT AND GERIATRIC PSYCHIATRY. I HAVE BEEN ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH THESE ACHIEVEMENTS DESPITE SEVERAL RECURRENCES OF MY DEPRESSIVE DISORDER. THE ADVENT OF THE SSRI'S AND OTHER ANTIDEPRESSANTS HAS HELPED ME TREMENDOUSLY. I CONTINUE ANTIDEPRESSANT THERAPY TO PREVENT FURTHER EXACERBATIONS. UNFORTUNATELY, A GREAT DEAL OF PREJUDICE AND IGNORANCE REGARDING MENTAL HEALTH, AND ITS APPROPRIATE TREATMENT, CONTINUES. WE, THEREFORE, ARE PROVIDING THIS TREATMENT IN A WAY THAT ENSURES COMPLETE CONFIDENTIALITY.
