The purpose of the grant is to support the development of a local community infrastructure that integrates substance use disorder treatment, housing services and other critical services for individuals, including youth, that are experiencing homelessness.</i>

<p>1. <u>BASIS/NATURE OF PROBLEM:</u></p> <p>Rappahannock Area Community Services Board has a strong partnership with MICAH ecumenical ministries which is a non-profit agency providing services to individuals who are chronically homeless or at risk of homelessness. This grant would afford us an opportunity to engage individuals who are often reluctant to participate in traditional treatment. Neither organization have a grant writer on staff or independent ability to prepare this grant.
