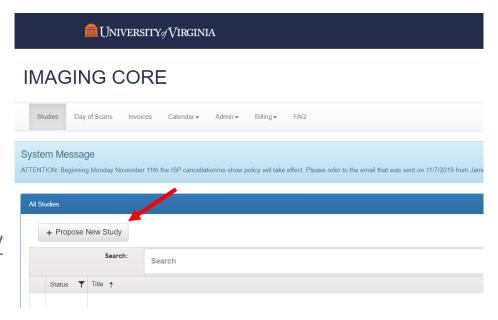

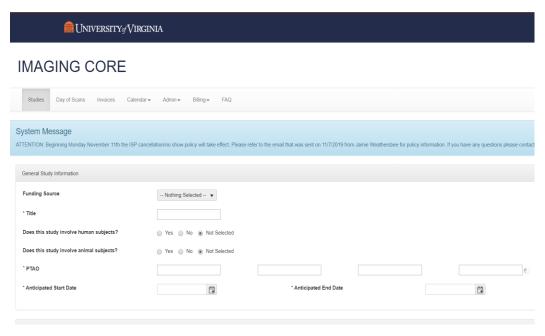


#### Study Proposal Requirements



#### All Imaging study proposals must include:

- Funding Source
- Title for the study
- Human or animal
- Valid PTAO
- Anticipated start and end date
- Primary Investigator along with any other staff member who will be involved with the study
- IRB Documentation or ACUC requirements for animal studies
- Specification of modality and number of cases to be performed
- Other supporting documents



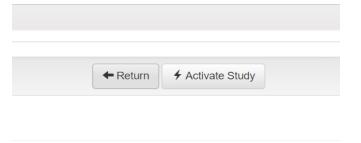
## Study Approval and Activation

- Imaging Core Director

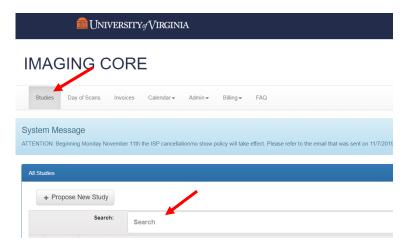
Following approval an email will be sent with a link to the CACS system so the requestor can activate the study. The activation icon can be found on the bottom of the page after going to the link.



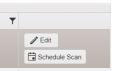
## Scheduling within CACS

 You will then select schedule scan to the right of the screen



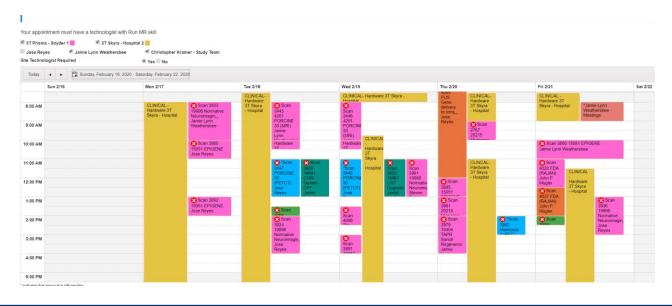
 You are then able to create a day of scan and add to your study cart—subject ID is required Create Day of Scan

## Scheduling within CACS



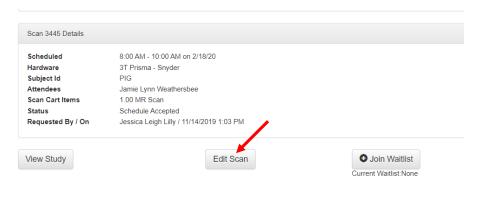
- You will then be able to select what date and time you need by clicking within the calendar field
