## Application for 4<sup>th</sup> Year Medical Student Leadership Program in Graduate Medical Education

**What**: The UVA GME Community is offering an embedded leadership experience for fourth year medical students. Our goal is to specifically increase the recruitment of URiM students and others with a strong interest in diversity to our GME training programs. In addition to participating in the clinical specialty elective of your choice, selected students will function as a cohort as you gain leadership skills, learn about the business of medicine, receive coaching to create successful applications and build interview skills as you pursue entry into residency programs. Participants will also benefit from networking with leaders and experts from both the Health System and other highly regarded Schools at UVA. Accepted visiting students may also apply for a limited number of \$1,500 scholarships (reimbursed following completion of the program) to help offset the cost of travel and housing.

**When**: The program will run in 4-week blocks (Blocks 7-10) July to October. You will be excused from clinical and didactic activities on the first three Friday afternoons and the final Thursday afternoon from 3-5pm, so that you can participate in workshops with the general theme of Leadership in Medicine, Addressing Health Inequities, Navigating ERAS and the Interview Trail, and Internship Survival Skills.

Additionally, students will be invited to a networking dinner with current resident members of UVA's Housestaff Council for Diversity and Inclusion.
