HEAVY TRAFFIC ON 29

When you're looking for a place to live, be aware that traffic on 29 North, especially at "rush hour" times, can be heavy. Some of our department members recommend living closer to the hospital so you can walk to work as needed. Also, be aware of move-in and move-out days for UVA, which can be found on their web-

site. Traffic on these days is extra chaotic, so we recommend traveling as little as possible those weekends!

WHERE THE * | BEEP| * DO YOU PARK?

While at first it might seem overwhelming, our department members have a few tricks to navigate parking in the city. Some prefer to avoid it altogether and walk or bike. Others have the park mobile app on their phone – finding paid parking is usually easy (and not too expensive, either!) A lot of places have free parking on Sundays and after 6pm during the week. You can also carpool or ride the university shuttles (which are free!) The most important thing to remember is you WILL get a ticket if you park somewhere you're not supposed to, so taking a few extra minutes to find a safe spot is definitely worth it!

CATCH THE SUNRISE AT LEAST ONCE




Charlottesville is a beautiful city, and the sunrises (and sunsets) are some of the best you'll ever see. At least once, drive up to the overlook off of Route 250 or 64 East (between the Afton exit 99 and the Crozet exit 107) to watch the sunrise. It's also a perfect place to watch sunsets, too!
