Lifestyle Coach Training for the CDC's National Diabetes Prevention Program










Created and developed an *online version* of the Lifestyle Coach Training.

In 2019 trained over 150 coaches from Virginia and throughout the United States in our online and in-person trainings.

Delivered Lifestyle Coach Training in high diabetes risk areas of Southwest VA, and TN. Provided free Lifestyle Coach Training to 30 participants in VA through grant funding.






Diabetes Prevention

Screening, Testing and Referral

For Prediabetes using EPIC and eClinical Works



- UVA EPIC: Investigated bidirectional referral system for prediabetes.
- UVA EPIC: Developed prediabetes registry, identification, testing and referral to National DPP using EPIC at UVA. Set up pilot test at Waynesboro Primary Care.
- UVA EPIC: Initiated prediabetes clinical strategy team at UVA.

- CVHS: Worked to gain support for CVHS to gain grant funding to develop eClinicalWorks Smartset and to pilot test prediabetes identification, testing and referral process to CVHS.
- CVHS: Facilitated bimonthly meetings with Central Va Health System health educators to develop CVHS prediabetes screening, testing and referral workflows.
- CVHS: Facilitated grant funding for CVHS to develop eClinicalWorks online prediabetes screening test.

- 66 Lifestyle Coaches from all 4 regions of the of state attended - Central, Tidewater, Northern and Southwest














WEIGHT LOSS AT WISE PROGRAM

Telehealth Distance Learning delivery of the National DPP to UVA employees at WISE campus




AVERAGE WEIGHT LOSS = 8.1%


Diabetes Management Tele-Education in VIRGINIA



- EXPANDED reach 4
 new clinics joined the
 DM series from around
 the state.
- DELIVERED three series= 12 CLASSES
- PROVIDED ACCESS to certified diabetes education to over 90 people with diabetes.
- ZOOM live video-conferencing used as the platform for delivery.


- UPDATED curriculum, and registration process for participating sites.
- PRESENTED at Russell County Diabetes Coalition Meeting.
- ORGANIZED iPad initiative for DSMES programming in Southwest VA. Pilot test Spring 2020.

DSMES and National DPP Telehealth Survey



- A Virginia state-wide survey to better understand the use, interest in, and barriers around using telehealth delivery for programming.
- 97% response rate for National DPP providers, and an 80% response rate for DSMES providers across the state.

And the survey says.....



- Few programs in Virginia are using Telehealth to deliver the National DPP (8%) or DSMES (14%).
- A minority of the programs use mHealth apps to engage patients (22% DPP; 8% DSMES) and only 1 DSMES used remote monitoring of blood glucose.
- Lack of reimbursement and perceived cost of technology are the primary barriers to using technology.

- Both groups of providers were "interested" in using telehealth as a delivery mode, but interest was subdued.
- Majority of both sets of providers report a lack of training in telehealth but the majority.
- 75% of National DPPs and 97% of DSMES would like further support and training.


